### **Responsibilities**

- Provide Cloud and/or SharePoint and collaboration tools training.
- Provide Cloud/SharePoint operational and support to MEF exercises and forces preparing to deploy.
- Develop software solutions using Microsoft SharePoint, InfoPath, .Net, ASP and HTML.
- Provide technical support in development of on-site SharePoint services, to include all necessary support software required to operate on-site SharePoint services to include SQL, Office Web Server, Windows Server, VMs, etc.
- Develop, implement, maintain, and document AWS Cloud and/or SharePoint Sites, Pages, Site Collections, and customizations by using new Web Parts, Cascading Style Sheets, Templates, security groups, workflows, custom forms and information exchanges.
- Participate in code reviews with peers and managers to ensure that each increment adheres to original vision as described in the user story and all standard resource libraries and architecture patterns as appropriate.
- Actively engage with clients before, during and after the build of solutions to ensure both expectations were met and long-term adoption is achieved.
- May respond to trouble/support calls for applications in production in order to make quick repairs to maintain high availability. Create or Update documentation in support of development efforts. Documents may include detailed specifications, implementation guides, architecture diagrams or design documents.
- Work with product owners and other development team members to determine new features and user stories needed in new or revised applications.
